The Plan

Each day will begin with a prayer meeting before breakfast for those who want to join and one of the preachers attending camp will close the day out with a sermon at the service after dinner. During the day a selection of tours, trips and outings will be on offer where you can enjoy the fellowship whilst exploring the local area. Otherwise you can laze around at camp or on the banks of the Boyne River. Whatever you find yourself doing, a cut lunch will be provided to take a long

We are planning guided 4x4 tours to Kroombit and Bulburrin National Park, fresh water boating and fishing on the Boyne River and Lake Awoonga and there is access to salt water on the Discovery Coast if enough fellas are up for the drive.

Adventure/Trail Bike Riding will be on offer this year. Rides will be fully guided with several routes on offer ranging from easy to moderately challenging. Estimated ride times will be anywhere from 3hrs to 5hrs, however you will need to provide your own motorbike.

The activities and outings for the camp are all planned around the equipment and generosity of other campers. So bring along your boat and four wheel drive that you are willing to bless others with and if you don't have anything to bring, then come along for the blessing.
